Designer Tips

Every scene has been designed to fit within an 8 inch Square or an 6 inch x 8 inch Rectangle Frame or Tunnel Card. Included on the USB are the files to make an 8 inch Square Box Frame, 6 inch x 8 inch Frame and an 8 inch x 10 inch Frame. There are also various Tunnel Card files to fit the different Scene sizes and number of layers.

Tunnel Card

For each size of Tunnel Card, there are different lengths of Sides depending on how many layers are needing to build each Scene.

Tunnel Card

- 1 x Back
- 1 x Front
- 2 x Layer Side
- Fold along the score lines on each of the Layer Sides to create a concertina.
- Taking each of the Layer Sides glue one of the tabs on each one in place onto the Back piece.
- Onto each of the folds on the Sides, glue in place the layers to build up the Scenes.
- Glue the Front piece in place onto the remaining tabs on the Side pieces.

Glue the Front Aperture in place onto the Front piece on the Tunnel Card.

Box Frame

Rectangle Frame

To cut the 8 x10 Frame you will need a 12 x24 inch Mat.

1 x Back 1 or Back 2

2 x Side

2 x Top and Base

1 x Frame Mat

- Resize the Side and Top and Base rectangle pieces so they are the desired depth and cut.
- Glue the tab pieces of the Side and Top and Base onto the solid pieces, use these tabs to form a box and create a side of the Frame.
- Glue each of the Side and Top and Base pieces in place onto the Back piece to make the Frame.
- 4. Glue the Frame Mat in place.
- 5. Glue your chosen Scene in place inside the Frame.
- As an extra cut the Frame Stand piece, layer up the pieces and glue it onto the back of the Frame to create a stand.

Square Frame

1 x Back

4 x Side

4 x Side Ends

1 x Frame Mat

- Resize the Side rectangle pieces so they are the desired depth and cut.
- Glue the tab pieces of the Sides onto the solid pieces, use these tabs to form a box and create a side of the Frame. Insert the Side Ends onto the ends of the pieces and secure with glue.
- Glue each of the Side pieces in place onto the Back piece to make the Frame.
- 4. Glue the Frame Mat in place on top of the Sides.
- 5. Glue your chosen Scene in place inside the Frame.
- 6. As an extra cut the Frame Stand piece, layer up the pieces and glue it onto the back of the Frame to create a stand.

Building the Scenes

In each folder for every Scene there is a Back piece and a Front piece along with each layer to build the scene and the corresponding Embellishments file to be glued in place onto that layer.

Box Frame

1 x Back

1 x Front

1 x Each numbered layer and Embellishments

Additional Item

Foam Tape

- Taking each layer glue the corresponding Embellishment layer in place creating the picture for that layer.
- 2. Place foam tape onto the back of each of the numbered layers.

- 3. Align layer 01 onto the back piece and attach in place.
- Continue aligning and attaching each of the layers in place onto the previous layer building up the scene.
- Glue or foam tape in place the Front piece onto the front of the layered scene.
- 6. Place your Scene into a Frame.

Tunnel Card

1 x Back

1 x Front

1 x Each numbered layer and Embellishments

 Taking each layer glue the corresponding Embellishment layer in place creating the picture for that layer. 2. Follow the instructions for the Tunnel Card to put the scene together.
