



Christmas



3D Rudolph Head

01 x 2

02 – 11 x 1

Nose Mat Layer x 4 (ideally in red cardstock)

1. Cut the files in the above quantities using a thick cardstock.
2. Mat the Nose Mat Layer pieces on to the nose section of the 01 pieces. .
3. Take the two 01 pieces and slot files 02 - 07 into this starting with 02 at the front and working towards the back.
4. Slot this into piece 08 and stick this to 09, 10, and 11.



Bow

1. Cut all pieces in the file.
2. With the longest piece, take both ends and glue them into the centre.
3. Take the smallest piece and wrap and glue this around the centre of the last piece.
4. Glue this to the remaining 'bow tie' shaped piece.



Christmas Pudding

8 x Christmas Pudding

8 x Icing

1 x Holly Topper or Holly Topper Elaborate (both if desired)

1. Cut the files in the above stated quantities.
2. Glue together the Christmas Pudding pieces using the tabs along the sides.
3. Glue together the Icing pieces using the tabs along the sides.
4. Glue the completed Icing piece on top of the completed Christmas Pudding piece.
5. Glue the berry shapes to the middle of the Holly piece and then glue this to the top of the completed pudding. Additional holly shapes can be added if desired.



Christmas Pudding Gift box

Base x 1
Icing Flower x 3
Icing x 3
Sponge x 6

1. Cut the files listed above in the stated quantities.
2. Using the tab at the base of the Icing Flower pieces, glue to three of the Sponge pieces.
3. Using the tab at the base of the Icing pieces, glue to the remaining three Sponge pieces.
4. Continue with the instructions for the Solid Cupcake from step 2.



Christmas Tree Box

Christmas Tree Box

1. Cut the Christmas Tree shape 4 times and the Square Base shape once.
2. Glue the tabs on the Christmas Tree shapes to the edges of the base.
3. Bring the tops of the trees together and secure with ribbon.



Cupcake Wraps

6 x Side (either Starry Wrap Side or Christmas Tree Wrap Side)

1 x Base

6 x Insert Panel (optional)

1. Cut the files in the quantities stated above.
2. If using, glue the Insert Panel pieces to the back of the Side pieces.
3. Glue the bottom tabs on the Side pieces to the edges of the Base piece.
4. Fold the Side pieces together and glue using the side tabs.



Cutlery Wraps

Elf Cutlery Wrap

1. Cut all pieces in the file once in desired cardstock.
2. Take the largest piece and glue the sides together using the tab. This will create the 'wrap'.
3. Glue the collar shape to the top front of the wrap (the shorter side) and the two buttons underneath this.
4. Thread the long strip through the buckle shape to create the belt. Glue this beneath the buttons taking the edges around the back of the wrap.

Snowman Cutlery Wrap

1. Cut all pieces in the file once in desired cardstock.
2. Take the largest piece and glue the sides together using the tab. This will create the 'wrap'.
3. Glue the tassel part of the scarf to the front of the neck part of the scarf. Glue this completed part to the top front of the wrap (the shorter side) and glue the two buttons beneath this.



Gingerbread House

Front x 1
Back x 1
Sides x 2
Base x 1
Roof Part 1 x 1
Roof Part 2 x 2
Front Detail x 1
Back Detail x 1
Side Detail x 2
Roof Detail x
Window x 2
Door x 1



1. Cut the files in the above quantities.
2. Mat the detail layers to the corresponding pieces.
3. Glue the Front and Back pieces to the base along the shortest sides of the base using the tabs.
4. Glue the sides to the base. Glue the front, back and sides together.
5. Glue Roof Part 1 and Roof Part 2 together using the tabs.
6. Glue the roof to the house.
7. Layer the roof detail pieces onto the roof.
8. Add the Window and Door details to the front and sides.

Matchbox Diorama

Matchbox

Matchbox Drawer x 1

Matchbox Wrap x 1

1. Cut the files in the above quantities.
2. Make up the matchbox drawer by gluing the tabs to the corresponding edges.
3. Make the wrap by folding along the score lines and gluing along the end tab.

Diorama

1. Cut all of the files once.
2. Layer the files in the matchbox starting with Layer 1 at the back and working forwards in numerical order.



Mini Stands

1. Cut all parts of the file.
2. Slot together the two base parts to make the stand.
3. Slot the round top part onto the stand.



Rocking Horse

Horse Body x 1
Legs x 2
Mane and Tail x 2
Rocker x 2
Saddle and Stirrups x 1
Structure Bar x 3

1. Cut the shapes in the quantities stated above.
2. Mat the Mane and Tail pieces to both sides of the Horse Body piece.
3. Take the Saddle pieces and fold the long part along the score line. Glue the stirrups into this.
4. Mat the completed Saddle and Stirrup pieces to both sides of the Horse Body.
5. Take the 2 Rocker pieces and slot the three Structure Bars into the middle slots to create your rocker.
6. Slot the Leg pieces into the Horse body piece.
7. Slot the 'hooves' into the edge slots on the rocker.



Secret Drawer Box

1. Cut all pieces in the file.
2. Take the two side box pieces and fold gently along the score lines.
3. Take the large tab that is a triangle shape and glue to the square side next to the cut.
4. Take the tab next to the triangle tab and glue to the same square side.
5. Tuck in and glue the remaining two tabs to create neat edges.
6. Repeat the above steps with the second part of the box.
7. Using the large tab on one of the box sides, glue to the other box side.
8. Make up the drawers by gluing each of the three drawers together using the tabs.
9. Take one drawer and glue to the base of one of the box sides.
10. Take another drawer and glue to the inside top of the same box side.
11. Take the last drawer and glue to the inside middle of the opposite box side.



Sleigh

Sleigh Box Middle x 1
Sleigh Box Sides x 2
Elaborate Sleigh Sides (optional)

1. Cut the files in the quantities stated above.
2. Make up the box middle by gluing the side shapes to the middle using the tabs.
3. Mat Elaborate Sleigh Sides to sleigh sides if using.
4. Make up the sleigh sides by gluing the runner shape along the bottom of the sleigh shape and the top edging along the top of the sleigh shape.
5. Glue the completed sides to the completed box middle.



Star Lantern

1. Cut 5 of your chosen design.
2. Glue along the long tab and stick to the opposite side to form the individual points of the star.
3. Fold the short tabs to the outside of the points, glue and use these to attach the points together.



Victorian Lantern

1. From the Victorian Lantern file cut one of the square base and four of the lantern side shape.
2. If desired, cut four of the Ornate Detail file and glue to the back of the side pieces.
3. Glue the sides to the base using the tabs.
4. Glue the sides together using the long tabs.
