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## Campervan



## Cutting List

## Van

1 x Back
1 x Base
$1 \times$ Front
$1 \times$ Roof
$1 \times$ Side 1
$1 \times$ Side 2
1 x Van Top
$1 \times$ Van Top 2
$1 \times$ Doors and Bumpers
$4 \times$ Seats

1. Fold the Roof on the score line and glue the tabs. You can also glue the Windows embellishments and the Roof Rack at this point.
2. Separately, glue the two pieces of the Base together. Then, glue Sides 1 and 2, following the wheel arches and add the Front and Back to the Base.
3. At this stage, you can add acetate to the windows to simulate glass and any interior details you wish to add.
4. Add the assembled Seats to the wheel arches.
5. Glue the Roof to the top of the van.

## Wheels

$1 \times$ Hub Caps
$1 \times$ Tyre Sides
$1 \times$ Tyre Treads

## Embellishments

$1 \times$ Windows
$1 \times$ Embellishments
6. Add the Doors and Bumpers and glue the windows and other embellishments like the door handles and lights.

TOP TIP: Before gluing all the sides together, you can add some lights to the front of the van.
7. Loop one of the Tyre Treads and glue to form a wheel. Fold the side tabs down and glue Tyre Sides, one on either side.
8. Glue the Hub Caps to the exterior of the wheels.

## Guitar



## Cutting List

## Body

Base x 1
Base $2 \times 1$
Sides x 1
Mat Back x 1
Mat Front x 1
Ornate Mat x 1

1. Glue the Base to the Sides. Once they are secure, add Base 2 to them.
2. Add both Mats to the guitar, gluing the piece with the hole cut in to the corresponding base piece.
3. Glue the Ornate Mat to the front of the guitar and add some of the embellishments to the body, like the Rosette and the Pick Guard.
4. Form the Neck by bending on the score lines and gluing together on the tabs.
5. Add the remaining Mats.
6. Glue the front and back segments to the sides of the headstock.
7. Add embellishments such as tuning pegs.

TOP TIP: Use thread or thin cord to recreate the strings of the guitar.

## Birdcage

## Cutting List

## Cage

$1 \times$ Bottom
1 x Perch
$1 \times$ Side with door
$7 \times$ Sides
$1 \times$ Top

1. Add the Perch and the decorated Bird to the base of the cage.
2. Glue the Sides and the Side with door to the Bottom.
3. Before gluing the sides to one another.
4. Glue the sides together and add the Top.
5. Glue the Base Sides to the bottom of the Base.
6. Build the Strut, folding on the score lines and gluing the Strut Top and Bottom to it.
7. Insert the strut to the base of the stand.

TOP TIP: You can add lights to the interior of the cage to transform it to a lamp.

$1 \times$ Base
$8 \times$ Base Sides
$1 \times$ Strut Top and Bottom
$1 \times$ Strut
$1 \times$ Bird


## Mail Box

## Cutting List

Box
$1 \times$ Base and Back
$1 \times$ Flag
$1 \times$ Lid
$1 \times$ Mats
$1 \times$ Side 1

1. Fold Sides 1 and 2 on the score lines and glue to the Base.
2. Once these are securely held, glue the Back on.
3. Add the Mats to the sides.
4. Using a split pin, put the Flag in the side where a cross is marked and cut.
5. Add the Mat to the lid of the mailbox.

## $1 \times$ Side 2

## Post

$1 \times$ Base
1 x Post
6. Using two split pins, fasten the Lid in place (using the cut crosses on both sides).
7. Glue the four sides of the Base to the bottom square piece. Glue the top to it.
8. For the Post, glue its four sides together and add the top and bottom pieces to them.
9. Glue both Post and Base together.


## Cake Stand



## Cutting List

$1 \times$ Side 1
$1 \times$ Side 2
$2 \times$ Mat Side 1
$2 \times$ Mat Side 2
$1 \times$ Top
$1 \times$ Top Mat

1. Glue both copies of Mat Side 1 to their corresponding copy of Side 1. Do the same with the other half of the stand.
2. Insert Side 2 to Side 1 and lock the pieces forming a cross shape as shown.
3. Add Top Mat 1 to the Top.
4. Place the top piece on the top of the stand.
5. Add glue if a stronger structure is desired.

## Handbag Box



Cutting List
1 x Box
$1 \times$ Mats

1. Add the Mats to the sides of the box and the flap.
2. Fold the Box at the score lines and glue together at the tabs.
3. Glue the flap to the back of the handbag and pass it through the handles to close the bag top.

## Segment Gift Box



Cutting List
$1 \times$ Box
$1 \times$ Mats
1 Tray Mat
1 sTray

1. Fold the Box on the score lines and glue together.
2. Add the Mats to the sides.
3. Four boxes can be built to fill the Tray if desired.

## Geometric Box



## Cutting List

$1 \times$ Base
$1 \times$ Lid
$1 \times$ Mat
$4 \times$ Side

1. Take one Side piece and glue it to the edge of the base using the longest tab. Repeat with another Side piece then glue the sides together using the tabs at the sides.
2. Fold the top section inwards and glue together at the sides using the small tabs to create a rim.
3. Glue the Lid to one edge of the top rim.
4. Decorate with the Mats to finish.

## Fold Top Box



1. Cut one of your chosen design.
2. Using the larger piece, fold along the score lines and glue the tabs to the corresponding sides.
3. Mat the small piece to the back of the detail section to finish.

## Favour Boxes



1. Cut one of your chosen design.
2. Assemble the two pieces by folding along the score lines and gluing together using the tabs at the sides.
3. Glue the decorative Lid section to the Box using the remaining tab.

## Hexagon Box



## Cutting List

$1 \times$ Box Base $1 \times$ Lid Mat
$1 \times$ Lid
$6 \times$ Side Mat
$1 \times$ Side

1. Using the Sides, fold along the score lines and glue together using the long tabs at the sides.
2. Glue the Sides to the Base using the small tabs.
3. Assemble the Lid by gluing the long side sections together using the small tabs at the sides, then glue the hexagonal piece to the top of this using the remaining tabs.
4. Decorate with the Mats to finish.

## Hinged Top Box



## Cutting List

1 x Box
$1 \times$ Lid Mat
$1 \times$ Lid

1. Assemble the Box by folding along the score lines and gluing the tabs to the corresponding sides.
2. Using one of the Lid pieces, assemble by folding along the score lines and gluing the tabs to the corresponding sides. Repeat with the remaining Lid piece.
3. Glue the Lid pieces to opposite sides of the Box using the remaining tabs.
4. Decorate with the Mats.
5. Thread a piece of ribbon through the holes in the lid and tie closed to finish.

## Tea Bag Holder



## Cutting List

$1 \times$ Box
$2 \times$ Front and Back
1 x Front Mat

1. Assemble the Box by folding along the score lines and gluing the tabs to the corresponding sides.
2. Glue both the Front and Back to the long sides of the box.
3. Mat the Front Mat to the front to finish.

## Gramophone



## Cutting List

Horn
1 x Elbow
$1 \times$ Horn Base
$8 \times$ Horn Mat
$8 \times$ Horn Side
$1 \times$ Strut

## Turntable

$1 \times$ Base
$1 \times$ Record Label
$1 \times$ Record
$4 \times$ Side Mat
$4 \times$ Side
$8 \times$ Top and Base Sides
$1 \times$ Top
$1 \times$ Turntable Mat

1. Using four of the Top and Base Sides, glue to the edges of the Base using the longest tab.
2. Glue the Top and Base Sides together using the tabs at the sides to create a complete base.
3. Take the Sides and glue them to the long tabs at the top of the base piece, then glue together using the tabs at the sides.
4. Using the four remaining Top and Base Sides, glue to the top of the Sides using the shorter of the long tabs.
5. Glue the Top and Base Sides together at the sides and glue the Top to the top of this to complete the basic turntable shape.
6. Take the Horn Sides and glue together using the tabs at the sides.
7. Glue the Horn Base to the remaining tabs on the Horn Side to complete the horn shape.
8. Using the longer section of Elbow 1, fold along the score lines and glue together using the tab at the end. Repeat with Elbow 2.
9. Glue the two elbow pieces together and glue the octagonal shape from each to the corresponding piece.
10. Using the Strut, fold the long piece along the score lines and glue together using the long tab to make a tube. Glue the octagonal shapes to each end.
11. Glue the horn piece onto the octagonal face on the Elbow 1 piece, then glue the octagonal face of Elbow 2 to one end of the strut.
12. Ensure the glue on the horn piece is fully dry, then apply glue to the bottom of the strut and slot through the hole in the turntable so that it goes right through and binds to the base. Hold in place until the glue has set.
13. Decorate with the Mats, Record and Record label to finish.

## Cutting List

## Back

$2 \times$ Front and Back
1 x Paper Table
$2 \times$ Ribbon Spool
$1 \times$ Roller Base and Sides
$1 \times$ Roller Ends
$1 \times$ Roller Top
$2 \times$ Sides
$2 \times$ Top and Base
1 x Typebar

Base
1 x Front Mat
$1 \times$ Sides
$2 \times$ Top and Base

## Keys

1 x Keys Back and Base
1 x Keys Front
40 x Keys
$1 \times$ Spacebar

## Sides

$1 \times$ Side 1 Mat
$1 \times$ Side 1
$1 \times$ Side 2 Mat
$1 \times$ Side 2

1. Using the Base Sides, glue to the edges of one of the Top and Base and glue together at the sides. Glue the remaining Top and Base to the other side to create the base box shape.
2. Using the Back Sides, Front and Back and Top and Bottom pieces, glue together using the tabs to create a box. Glue this to the top of the base section, ensuring that they are aligned at the back.
3. Take the large Keys Front piece and starting at the top edge, alternate mountain and valley folds along the score lines. Glue this piece to the edges of the 'steps' shaped pieces to create the staircase effect on the front of the keyboard.
4. Take the Key Base Back, fold along the score line and glue to the back of the section completed in step 3 . Glue this section to the base section so it sits in front of the back box to create the shape shown in the image. This is the basic typewriter shape.
5. To create the Roller piece, take the Roller Top and glue to the curved edges of the two Roller Sides. Glue the Roller Base to the bottom of this.
6. Using two of the circular Roller Ends, and one of the long tabbed pieces, glue the tabs to the edges of the circle to create a solid shape. Repeat with the remaining pieces and glue one to each end of the completed roller section.
7. Glue the completed roller section to the top of the back section ensuring it is positioned centrally and aligned with the back.
8. Glue the Paper Table to the back of the typewriter so the decorative part sits above the roller.
9. Glue the Typebar in front of the roller so it sits centrally.
10.Using the Ribbon Spool, glue the long tabbed piece to the edges of the circles to create a solid shape. Glue the decorative piece to the top and put one completed spool either side of the Typebar.
11.Using the Side 1 and Side 2, glue to either side of the typewriter.
12.Mat the outline shapes of the Keys and Space Bar to the top of the solid shapes and organise on the keyboard section.
13.Decorate with the Mat pieces to finish.

## Ornate Vase



## Cutting List

$8 \times$ Base Sides
$1 \times$ Base Top and
Bottom
$8 \times$ Side Mat
$1 \times$ Vase Base
$8 \times$ Vase Side

1. Using the Base Sides, glue to the edges of the largest Base Top and Bottom piece.
2. Glue the Base Sides together using the tabs at the sides and glue the remaining Base Top and Bottom piece to the top.
3. Using the Vase Sides, glue together using the tabs at the sides.
4. Glue the Vase Base to the bottom tabs of the Vase Sides.
5. Glue the completed vase shape to the completed base shape.
6. Decorate with the Mats to finish.

## Small Vase



## Cutting List

$1 \times$ Base
$6 \times$ Side Mat
$6 \times$ Side

1. Glue the Sides together using the tabs along the edges.
2. Glue the Base to the bottom tabs.
3. Decorate with the Mats to finish.

## Tie Top Box



## Cutting List

Box x 1
Sides x 2

1. Using the Box piece, assemble by gluing together using the tabs at the sides.
2. Take one of each of the Sides pieces and mat together from smallest to largest. Repeat with the remaining Sides pieces.
3. Glue the completed Sides pieces to the sides of the Box piece.
4. Thread ribbon through the holes at the top and tie to finish.
